This is an information package for parents of boys registered for one of our BMX Camps. We are excited that you decided come this summer and can't wait to see you! Please make sure you take the time to read through the general Camp Information Package as well as the following information.

Below is some information about what is needed for camp and some of the things your child will be doing while at Circle Square Ranch.

- Your child will need their own BMX bike and set of knee pads, elbow pads and a helmet. We highly suggest a full-face helmet but a regular bike helmet is acceptable. There are bikes and pads at Circle Square Ranch but they are on a first-come-first-served basis and must be shared with the regular western camp. Shin guards are recommended but not required.
- There is a road-trip planned for each week of BMX camp. Campers will travel to 5 different skate parks on Tuesday and Wednesday, staying overnight at a church in Drumheller and arriving back at the Ranch in time for supper on Wednesday evening. They will also travel to the Stettler skate park on Friday morning and be back at the Ranch for lunch.
- In order for a camper to participate in the road-trips, an additional waiver is needed so we can take your child off the Ranch property. The waiver follows this page. Please sign it and bring it with you on registration day.
- On SATURDAY at the end of their week of camp, there will be a BMX JAM held at the Circle Square Ranch skate park beginning at 12:15 pm. It is for the BMX campers to show off their skills to their parents and friends. It is very low pressure with fun being the primary goal. There will be prizes for categories including highest bunny hop, highest air, best trick and others. The formal part of the Jam will end around 1:00pm. Once the Jam begins, you are responsible for the supervision of your child.
- SIGN-OUT on SATURDAY will be at the Western Camp Rodeo Grounds from 12:00-1:00 pm at the Trading Post (refreshments building). After the rodeo, SIGN-OUT then moves to the lobby desk in the Western Town Hotel until the end of the Jam. BMX Camp attendees will not be riding in the regular rodeo, but will take part in the Grand Entry at the beginning of the event.





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WAIVER FORM

Conditions of Attendance:

1. The Ranch Director reserves the right to dismiss a guest who, in their opinion, is a hazard to the safety and rights of others, or who appears to have rejected the reasonable controls of the Ranch.
2. If the guest attending Circle Square Ranch is less than 18 years of age, the parents or guardians submitting this form are those who have legal custody of the child.
3. While every precaution shall be taken to ensure the good welfare and protection of the guest, Intervarsity Christian Fellowship, Circle Square Ranch, its Directors, staff members, employees, or facilities outside the Ranch grounds are hereby released from any and all liability in the event of any loss, accident, misfortune, personal injury or damage to personal property that may occur to the guest.

In the event that a guest requires special medication, x-ray, or treatment beyond that which is possible at the Ranch, the guest will be responsible for any additional expense for additional care or transportation; if the guest is under 18 years of age the parents or guardians will be notified immediately.
- 5. I understand that while in attendance at Circle Square Ranch my child (who is under 18 years) will be taken off the Ranch property for 2 road-trips to ride at several public or provincial skate parks in Alberta.**
- 6. I understand that the liability coverage in my household insurance will be listed as the primary coverage for the event at Circle Square Ranch, and that Circle Square Ranch will be listed as secondary for this same event.**
